## III.1 Residing programme: IQST Writer in Residence

## Content, objective and scope

The IQST residing programme invites science writers, editors and journalists at the IQST institutes to shine light on quantum science from new angles. The scientists, in turn, learn from the writers about the challenges of getting science attractively in the media. The IQST Writer in Residence is embedded in different research groups, visits labs, sits in group meetings, and in general has plenty of person-to-person exchanges with the IQST community. In interacting with world-renowned scientists, the writers discover new approaches to communicate emerging ideas to the general public.

## Funding

The residing programme covers costs for travel and accommodation during the stay for up to six months at IQST institutes. The funds are intended to strengthen the communication about IQST's research and enhance its visibility.

### **Review Criteria**

- science writer, editor, journalist, or similar
- interaction with the IQST community via visits at different institutes, lab-tours and meetings with scientists
- giving series of talks or host a workshop about scientific writing or similiar (incl. video stream to all IQST locations)
- previous publications
- hosted and administered directly by an IQST Fellow

## Application

Applicants (Writers together with a host) are invited to submit a proposal to the IQST office igst@igst.org. The proposal will be reviewed and decided upon by the IQST board.
